Please adopt ALL of the recommendations that came from the technical advisory group, including an exemption from setback requirements when solar panels cover less than 40% of the home's roof area. Requiring most potential solar installations to get fire official review before proceeding would put undue hardship on the solar contractors. It would seriously hurt sales in one of the few growing industries in the state.

Systems would be smaller in size and many homes with multiple roofs would be unable to, cost effectively, install any solar at all.
